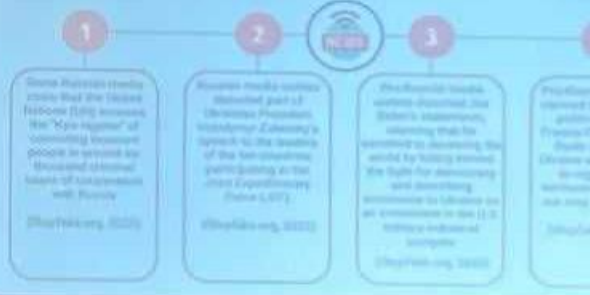

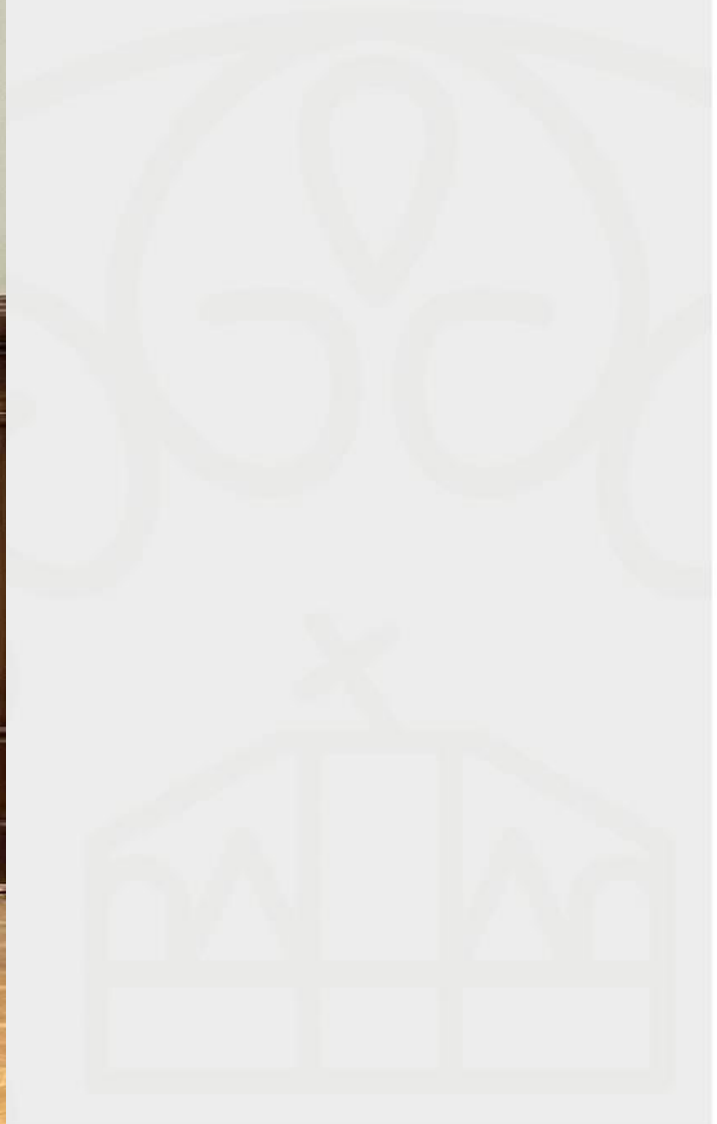
Fake News in the conflict

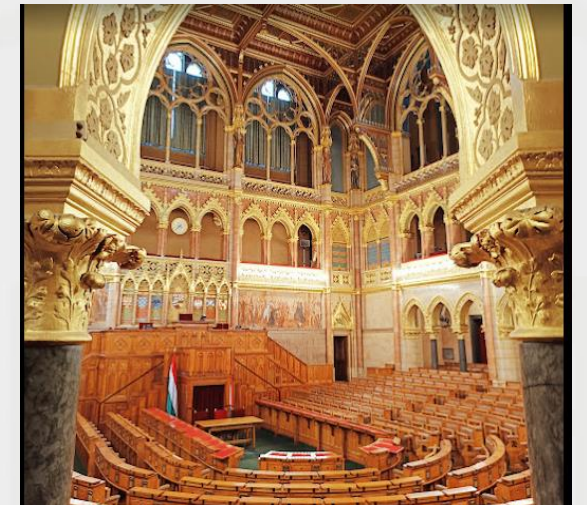
