A total of thirty-three students from the Higher Military Educational Institutions of Greece, European countries (Bulgaria, Spain, Italy, Poland, Romania, Latvia), as well as students from Greek Universities participated in the above programme.











During this program, Greek and other European distinguished speakers presented topics related to the following thematic areas:

- **EU strategy in the training of young executives** of the EU.
- The **EU strategy on maritime security** for the new generation of young EU staff.
  - Regional and international approach to maritime security.
- Maritime security threats (hybrid threats, asymmetric threats, drones and cyber security).
  - Impact of space technology on maritime security.
  - Legal approaches to maritime security.
  - Contribution of the **private sector to maritime security**











The participants worked on hypothetical maritime security scenarios and then a practical demonstration of a piracy scenario at sea, on board the VMS PANDORA and its response by OAP/DYK was carried out.













In addition, visits of the participants were made to the Naval Base "TH/K ABEROF", the Museum and the Holy Rock of Acropolis.
