For whom is the conference intended?

The conference is intended for researchers, academic staff, teachers, security sector practitioners, and students interested in language education, the influence of the ongoing technological boom, and shifts in the international security environment on foreign language competences, language teaching and learning, but also language testing.

The maximum number of participants is 50 academic staff, teachers, and security sector practitioners, and 20 students/cadets (on a first come, first served basis; a maximum of 4 student participants per institution/university).

The entire week of October $13^{th} - 17^{th}$, 2025, will cover an **International Week** at the UoD Language Centre. Therefore, this week is a great opportunity to organize an internship/staff mobility at the Language Centre and/or attend the conference
